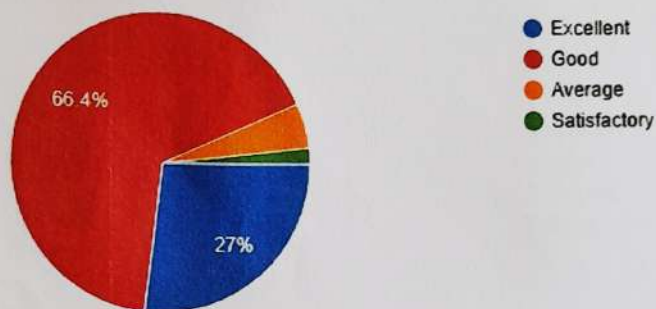

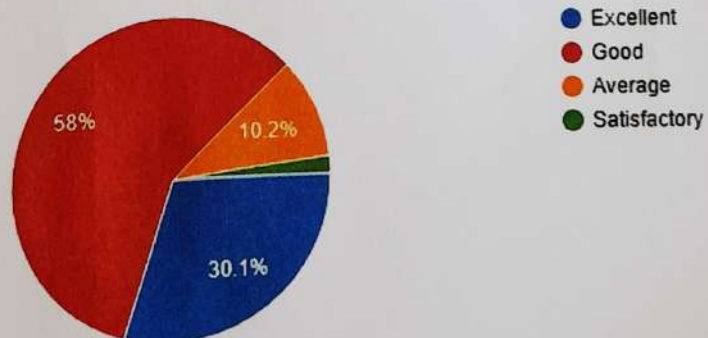

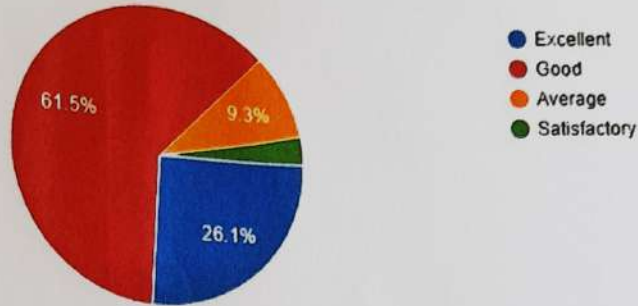

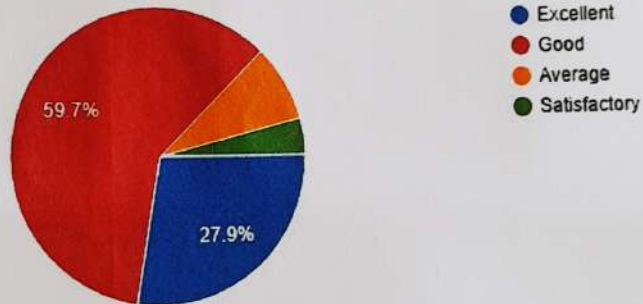
Syllabus is Career oriented.

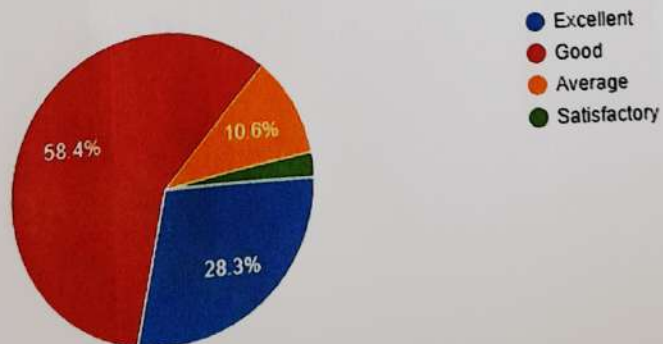
Syllabus in comparison with other University

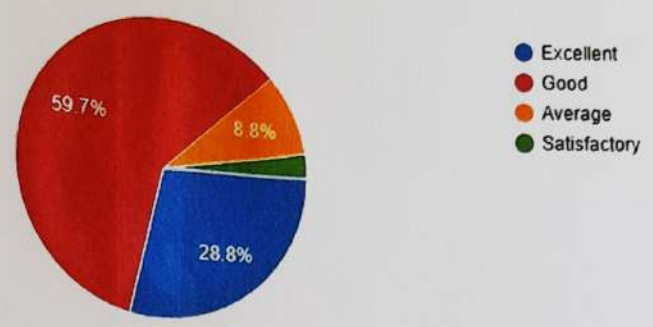


Applicability of syllabus to real life situation.

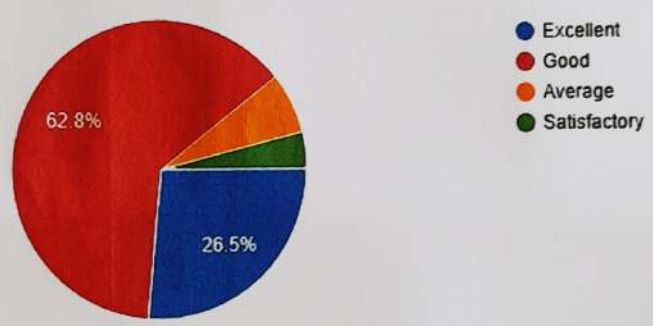

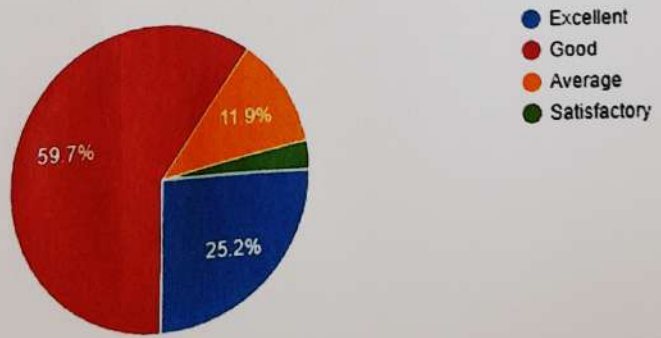
Availability of study material (reference material and books).

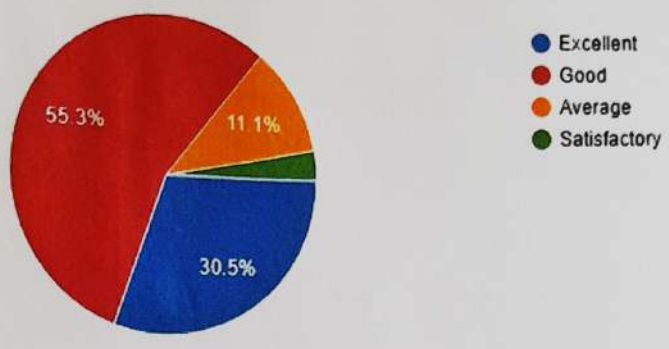
Extent of the coverage of course

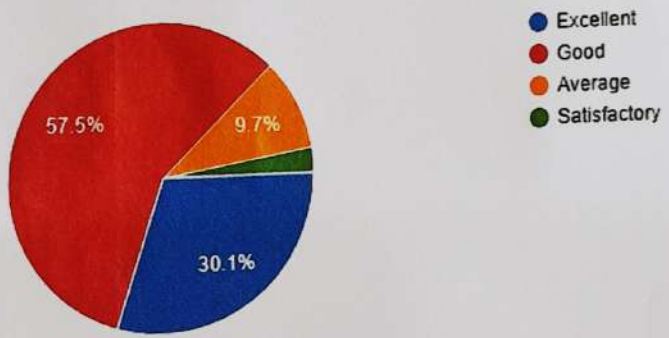
Continuous Internal evaluation- college unit test usefulness to face main exams

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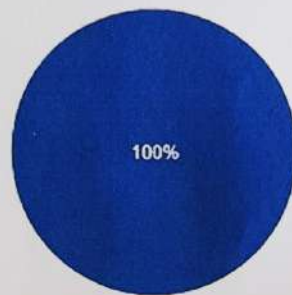

1. Do you feel that the syllabus clarifies your teaching goals?

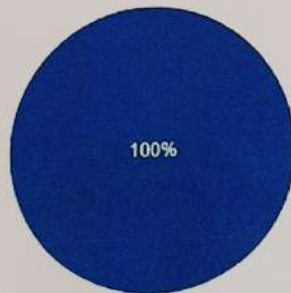

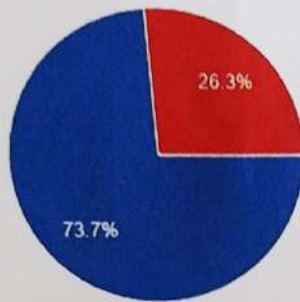

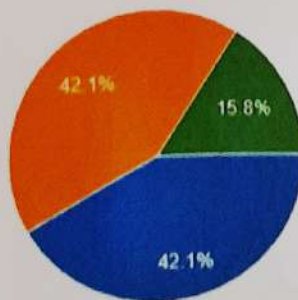
